The Judiciary Act of 1789 gave the Supreme Court original jurisdiction to issue writs of mandamus (legal orders compelling government officials to act in accordance with the law). A suit was brought under this Act, but the Supreme Court noted that the Constitution did not permit the Court to

have original jurisdiction in this matter.

This Order authorizes remote attendance at depositions in civil cases without stipulation or court order. Due to the continuing challenges of conducting in-person depositions during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Supreme Judicial Court, pursuant to its superintendence and rule-making authority, issues the following ORDER.

In an emergency order posted Friday, the Texas Supreme Court extended until September 15 the limitations on civil case filings and service of them for deadlines that fall between March 13, 2020, and September 1. As with previous orders, the extensions do not include deadlines for perfecting appeal or for other appellate proceedings.
