Timoshenko also wrote two other books, Engineering Education in Russia and As I Remember (his autobiography). In 1957, the American Society of Mechanical Engineers established a medal named after Dr. Timoshenko. He became its first recipient. The Timoshenko Medal is given annually for distinguished contributions in applied mechanics.

In 1963 Timoshenko wrote a book As I Remember in the Russian language. It was translated into English in 1968 by sponsorship of the Stanford University. Timoshenko was professor of engineering mechanics at Michigan for just nine short years (1927-1936), in the era between the two World Wars, but his brief presence on the Ann Arbor campus had a profound impact not just on his students but on the entire field.
