Outline geographic areas affected by the disaster. Distribute prioritized list of sites/areas to be assessed, provide maps. Assign sites to specific teams.

Based on the findings of the damage assessment, the organization's management will be in a position to decide whether to 1) reopen the office, 2) close the office, 3) reopen the office with limited access, 4) activate technology disaster recovery plans, 5) activate business continuity plans, 6) activate alternate work area recovery plans, 7) activate hot/cold site recovery initiatives or 8) develop and launch an alternate strategy.

Local Damage Assessment Must be Rapid, Detailed and Accurate. • It should be completed and submitted within 36 hours of the event. • The information collected will then be analyzed to determine if supplemental assistance will be needed from State and/or Federal Agencies. • If necessary, the State will request a preliminary damage assessment with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and/or the Small Business Administration (SBA).
