Maya script, also known as Maya glyphs, was the writing system of the Maya civilization of Mesoamerica and is the only Mesoamerican writing system that has been substantially deciphered. Maya writing is possibly the most advanced form of writing developed in ancient Mesoamerica. Over 800 glyphs represent different aspects of Maya culture, from mathematics and calendrics to kings, gods, and food. About 85 percent of the known Maya glyphs have been deciphered, but there is still much more to learn.
