The process and goal of porting is simple—to remove small amounts of metal that inhibit airflow through the cylinder heads. “It’s a little intimidating to some folks, but with a careful touch and patience, anyone can port their own heads,” Davin says as he prepares the die grinder to get started.

Remove the valve cover and the intake manifold and then unbolt the cylinder head. 4 Lift both the cylinder head and the exhaust manifold off together. This is without having to remove the exhaust manifold from the cylinder head.

### **How to Easily Remove a Cylinder Head on an Auto With ...**

Turn the head upside down, fill a chamber with fluid, angle the head to completely immerse one of the valves, then take an air gun, stick its wand into the intake or exhaust port, and shoot compressed air at the valve seat and look for bubbles in the fluid. As with the drip test, ideally you should see no bubbles at all.

Draw a rough outline of the cylinder head on a piece of cardboard and punch holes for each bolt location. Then, remove the cylinder head bolts and insert them in the corresponding holes. Remove each cylinder head bolt and store it in its respective slot in the cardboard until you are ready to reinstall the cylinder head. 5.
