## **Developmental/Behavioral Health Screening Tools**

SCORING THE PEDIATRIC SYMPTOM CHECKLIST-17 (PSC-17) • The PSC-17 is a shortened version of the PSC-35 and consists of 17 items. • Each item is rated as “NEVER,” “SOMETIMES,” or “OFTEN” present and scored 0, 1, and 2 respectively. • The total score is calculated by adding together the score for each of the 17 items.

The Pediatric Symptom Checklist (PSC) helps pediatricians and pediatric nurse practitioners improve the recognition of psychosocial problems in their patients. The PSC is designed to fit into the workflow of a primary care practice and can be used to alert families of psychosocial and emotional issues.
