Also called the "complaint" in some states, the petition informs the court of the filing spouse's (called the "petitioner ") desire to end the marriage, and its filing with the court signifies the initiation of the divorce process.

### **Filing an Original Petition for Divorce**

Dissolution, commonly referred to as divorce, is the process of cutting the legal, marital ties between two people through the court system. In a dissolution, the parties divide and distribute property, can ask for spousal maintenance (alimony or money from the other person to live on), and, if there are children resulting from the marriage, a parenting plan and child support.

A dissolution of marriage or a RDP is started when one spouse or partner files a petition for dissolution. The spouse or partner who files the petition is called the petitioner. The other spouse or partner is called the respondent. Both parties can file a joint petition, in which case they are co-petitioners.
