They mistakenly think that positive means 'good' and negative means 'bad'. But this is not what Skinner meant. Positive meant the application of a reinforcer while negative meant the removal of one. Positive reinforcement is similar to the idea of an incentive. Negative reinforcement is more like intimidation or a threat.

Delivering Positive Reinforcement Finding balance between positive and negative consequences Clients often ask us to define the desired balance between positive and negative consequences when shaping or sustaining behavior. Research on the words we use supports using a minimum ratio of four positive comments to one negative comment (a 4:1 ratio), but there is more to it than that.
