The unveiling is the formal removal of a veil, a cloth, or handkerchief draped over the stone. It symbolizes the erection of the tombstone. The unveiling may be executed during the service by anyone the family designates. The service consists of the recitation of several Psalms, the eulogy, the removal of the veil, the malei rachamim, and Kaddish.

A Jewish Unveiling of a Tombstone - Death & Mourning

Headstone Unveiling Ceremony Before the ceremony begins, the headstone is covered in a sheet or cloth. The family can place the cloth on the headstone, or the cemetery staff may be able to coordinate this. Those in attendance gather around the headstone and recite psalms and perhaps a brief eulogy before removing the cloth.

Generally, the unveiling of a headstone is a private service for family and close friends. The service is ordinarily very short and simple, consisting of a handful of prayers, an abbreviated eulogy and the Kaddish. The service is usually led by a rabbi or cantor, but there is no requirement.
