Vernacular architecture of Jharkhand. The walls were made of a special type of mud obtained by souring earth by adding vegetable waste and leaving it to mature. The decaying waste produced tannic acid and other organic colloids, greatly improving the mud's plasticity (Cooper & Dawson, 1998).(Figure 1) This mud was then mixed with cow dung, chopped straw, and gravel or stones to make the raw material for the walls.
